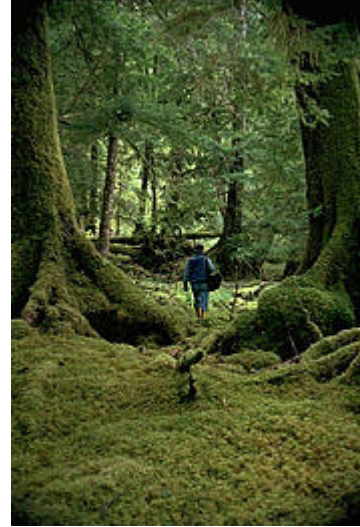


1. Located near the equator and filled with millions of plants and animals. The temperature ranges between 70-90 degrees and the area gets lots of rain!



2. Covers 70 % of the Earth. It is home to many types of fish, mammals, and plants. The water in this area is salty.



3. A place that is so cold that plants and animals struggle to survive. The

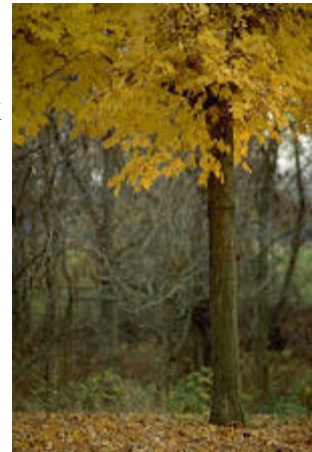


land is covered by snow most of the year. Animals that can survive must hibernate in the winter. Animals found there include reindeer and penguins.

4. These areas are known to be hot and dry. Animals are active at night. Little rainfall occurs, so there are few plants. Some organisms found there include cacti, rodents, and snakes.



5. The trees found in this area do not have cones. The trees tend to lose their leaves once each year. The summers are warm and the winters are cool. Deer, black bears, and squirrels live in this area.



6. The trees in this area have cones. The winters are cold and long. Deer and brown bears inhabit the land.

7. Grasses are the main form of plant life. Grazing animals, such as, giraffes, lions, and cheetahs also live in the area.
